# Value of Boundary Agreements

- Serves as consistent planning tool for both communities.
- 2. Establishes a common boundary line between the communities.
- 3. Provides for utility service area planning.
- 4. Excellent example of intergovernmental cooperation.

# **Proposed Agreement**

- Sections 1,2,4 and 7 Set the common boundary line as Interstate 80.
- Section 3 Provides for cooperation between communities regarding any Will County land development.
- Section 8 Encourages the communities to work together of promoting development of the corridor.

# **Proposed Agreement**

- Section 9 Allows for the previously approved final 8 dwelling units of the "senior citizen only" Smith Crossing.
- Section 11 Provides for utility planning along the common boundary line.
- Section 15 Sets the term of the Agreement at 20 years.
