Deduct Meter Information

What is a Deduct Meter?

A Deduct Meter measures the amount of water not discharging into the sanitary sewer system, such as water used for lawn irrigation systems or outside hose connections. There shall be no permanent or temporary water piping system that passes water from the deduct meter to any interior water outlet. The measurement of the Deduct Meter shall be deducted from the consumer's sewer usage based upon the reading of the primary water meter.

Where can I get a Deduct Meter?

Deduct Meters are available for purchase at the Mokena Village Hall. The current fee for a permit to install a Deduct Meter is listed on the application. Deduct Meters must be installed similar to regular water meters, complete with pull wire between the meter and the outside readout. The Deduct Meter pull wire may be run in the same conduit as the regular meter wherever feasible.

Who can install a Deduct Meter?

It is the responsibility of the applicant to arrange for the Deduct Meter installation by a plumber licensed by the State of Illinois. All such plumbers must also be registered as a contractor by the Village of Mokena.

Note: The Deduct Meter must be installed after the main water meter, and located in the same area. All meters must be installed no higher than 4 feet above the floor, and must be accessible. All hose connections must be protected by a vacuum breaker. All underground sprinkling systems must have backflow preventers (RPZ Valve).

My Deduct Meter is installed, now what do I do?

Once the Deduct Meter is installed, the applicant must contact the **Water Department at (708) 479-3926** to schedule the sealing of the meter and the installation of the outside readout. The Deduct Meter will then be in service.

The Village retains the right to inspect and test any Deduct Meter at any time, as needed to verify compliance with all applicable regulations. Violation of any Water and Sewer ordinance may result in nullification of the Deduct Meter readings, removal of the Deduct Meter, and a maximum of \$500.00 fine.

Can I get a refund if I'm not going to use the Deduct Meter after it has been purchased?

- ◆ No refunds will be given for any Deduct Meter that has been used.
- ◆ If the permit is more than 6 months old, and the Deduct Meter has not been installed, there will be a \$75.00 processing fee deducted from the refund.
- ◆ If the Deduct Meter was issued in duplication, or is returned unused within six months, a full refund will be issued.
